* Activities are grouped in 3 types:

SY = Symposia (Conference, Meetings, Workshops etc) / **SA** = Support Actions (Data Assembly, Website Input etc) / **OU** = Outreach (Publication, Dissemination etc)

** Activities are grouped in 3 categories:

A = stands for synthesis activities that deliver a significant element towards the anticipated synthesis of a Priority Topic. Outcomes should be published products that feed directly and in the given timeframe (i.e., the Interim Synthesis and evaluation of the LOICZ Phase in 2009/2010) into the delivery of the Science Plan and Implementation Strategy (SPIS).

B = stands for activities that either have a long-term perspective and are undertaken to support networking or set the stage for follow-up activities (e.g., implementation strategies for collaborative activities with multi-year duration) or for a regional involvement (i.e., strategic in perspective and context).

C = stands for external activities (e.g., conferences) where LOICZ participates but not necessarily through an own session, or where travel and participation of third parties (can be SSC but doesn't have to) is being encouraged/supported in the name of LOICZ to improve networking and / or contribute to relevant scientific activities.
