

Strategic Plan 2011-2015

- Build on and learn lesson from Strategic Plan 2006 - 2010
- Inputs from broad range of stakeholders and Member Countries are at the centre of its process
- Informed by discussion on Core Functions of MRC
- Consistent with outcome-oriented approach and results-based M & E system



Long-term funding & Core Functions of the MRC

- Gradual shift from external funding to Member Country funding
- Move from process and tools development to routine functions implemented by Member Countries
 - i.e. Hydrological data collection
 - i.e. Water quality testing



Four Core Functions of the MRC

- (i) Secretariat Administrative and Management Functions
- (ii) River Basin Management Functions;
- (iii) Tools Development and Capacity Building Functions;
- (iv) Consulting and Advisory Functions



Seven River Basin Management Functions

- 1. Data acquisition, exchange and monitoring
- 2. Analysis, modelling and assessment
- 3. Planning support
- 4. Forecasting, warning and emergencies
- 5. Implementing MRC procedures
- 6. Promoting dialogue and coordination
- 7. Reporting and Dissemination

Why is your participation important? (cont.)

How helpful will your participation be?

Consultations are expected to help:

- Gain national perspectives on future strategic directions of the MRC
- Provide inputs to the refinement of MRC Core Functions and the setting of priorities
- Consider existing Goal statements, whether they need to be modified
- Indentify MRC Core Functions that relate to specific Line Agencies

- Identify which activities under the MRC Core Functions could be implemented within the Member Country administration in the future
- Prepare feedback on key questions
- Consolidate and submit national inputs papers
- Comment and shape the Implementation Plan

Strategic goals in SP 2006-2010

- To promote and support coordinated, sustainable and pro-poor development;
- To enhance effective regional cooperation;
- To strengthen basin-wide environmental monitoring and impact assessment; and
- To strengthen the Integrated Water Resources Management capacity and knowledge base of the MRC bodies, NMCs, Line Agencies, and other stakeholders
