- A series of protocols in the 1995 Agreement for Member Countries to notify each other about major infrastructure developments on the Mekong or tributaries.
- Dams on a Mekong tributary must notify other member Countries.
- Mainstream developments subject to rigorous prior consultation with Member Countries.










