CP/RES. 206 (279/77)

REQUEST BY THE ARAB REPUBLIC OF EGYPT TO ACCREDIT A PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

CONSIDERING:

That by means of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71), the General Assembly established the status of Permanent Observers to the Organization of American States and entrusted the Permanent Council with the task of determining the criteria and timeliness to give effect to this provision and to implement it;

That pursuant to resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72), non-American states that participate in programs of the Organization may request the benefits set forth in resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71); and

HAVING SEEN: the request presented by the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt (CP/doc.653/77) for granting of the above-mentioned benefits, and the information provided by the General Secretariat, which confirms that this country is participating in programs of the Organization; and

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT: that the aforementioned country has expressed interest in having its designated Permanent Observer be accredited to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization,

RESOLVES:

1. To agree to the request of the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt, in accordance with the terms of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71) of the General Assembly and resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) of this Council.
2. The Permanent Observer designated by the Government of the Arab Republic of Egypt shall be understood to be accredited to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization. As regards the Specialized Organizations, the provisions of paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) shall apply.
3. To request the Secretary General to take whatever measures may be necessary to implement this resolution.
