CP/RES. 314 (439/80)

REQUEST BY THE GOVERNMENT OF SAUDI ARABIA
TO ACCREDIT A PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION

THE PERMANENT COUNCIL OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES,

CONSIDERING:

That by resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71), the General Assembly established the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States and entrusted the Permanent Council with the task of determining the criteria and timeliness to give effect to that provision and implement it; and

That in accordance with resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/71) non-American states that participate in programs of the Organization may request the status of Permanent Observer to the OAS, in accordance with resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71);

HAVING SEEN the request presented by the Government of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia that it be granted the aforementioned benefits (CP/doc.1078/80 corr. 1), as well as the information presented by the General Secretariat, in which it is stated that that country has shown its desire to participate in programs of the Organization (CP/doc.1078/80 add.; 1); and

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT the fact that that country has shown interest in having the Permanent Observer it designates accredited to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization,

RESOLVES:

1. To accede to the request by the Government of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia in accordance with the terms of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71) of the General Assembly and resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) of this Council.

2. That the Government of the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia may accredit Permanent Observers to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization. With respect to accreditation to the Specialized Organizations, the provisions of operative paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) shall govern.

3. To request the Secretary General to take the steps necessary to carry out this resolution.
