## Purpose of PCCR 2009

- **1. To update PICTs on regional and international actions undertaken in support of the Framework and Action Plan;**
- **2. To produce a matrix which would provide an overview of ongoing and planned activities at the national and regional levels, with responsible agencies or entities;**
  - to agree on mechanisms for measuring progress;
  - to identify difficulties, and
  - to address actions needing special attention;
- **3. To assist donors to gain an understanding of climate change initiatives in the region and allow for better targeted assistance to areas in the Action Plan where there are gaps;**

## **Purpose of PCCR 2009 (continued)**

- **4. To share lessons learned from best practices in the implementation of climate change programmes;**
- **5. To engage a wide range of stakeholders and regional organizations;**
- **6. To provide an opportunity to prepare for international meetings of the UNFCCC;**
- **7. To disseminate information on new and existing funding modalities and opportunities.**
